- Why do we fear death?

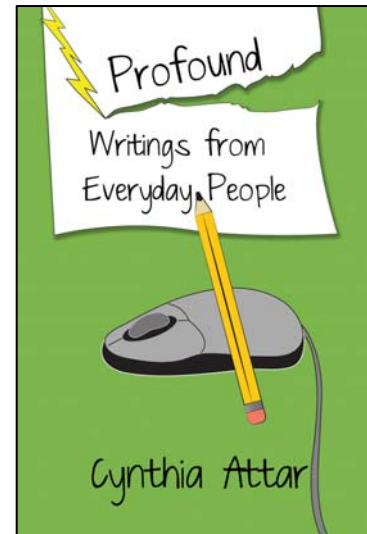
