About the Author

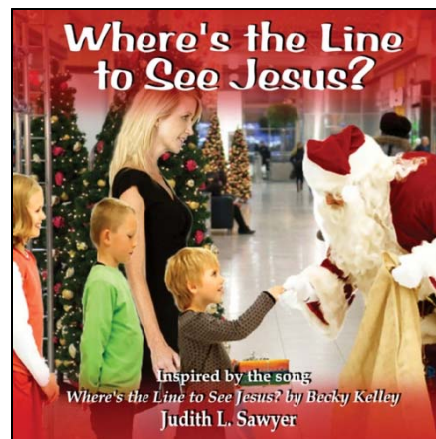
